

**CANADIAN JUNIOR BEEF EXTREME  
SECTION 109J**

**SHOW:** 9:00 a.m., Saturday, November 26 - Stadium

**JUDGE:** Kevin Brown, Ontario



**ENTRY DEADLINE:** October 1 (manual), October 15 (on-line).

Livestock entered in the Canadian Junior Beef Extreme (other than those in the open beef shows) may start entering barns at 9:00 a.m., Thursday, November 24 and must be in the barn and in place by 8:00 a.m., Friday, November 25. **Contact the barn boss upon arrival.** They will be released **7:00 p.m., Saturday, November 26.**

**SHOW RULES**

The Competition is open to all youth between 9 & 21 years of age as of December 31 of the current year.

1. A youth exhibitor by making entry, agrees to the Rules and Regulations printed herein, and where applicable, to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition.
2. **Entries close October 1.** Entry must be made on the Canadian Junior Beef Extreme Entry Form, for each animal entered and must be submitted to Canadian Western Agribition along with applicable entry fees. The signature of the owner **MUST** be on the entry form. Visit [www.agribition.com](http://www.agribition.com) to enter on-line and have extended entry deadline of October 15.
3. **Entry Fee:** \$15.00/entry. If animal is NOT entered in the open show, entry fee is \$35.00/entry plus Tie-Out Fee: \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
4. Animal must be shown by the youth exhibitor named on the entry.
5. Animals must be owned by the youth exhibitor, the immediate family or farm corporation, however **the youth exhibitor must be named on the entry.**
6. A minimum of eight (8) head per breed must be entered in order for a breed to qualify for a breed show. If numbers are insufficient to make a breed show, an "All Other Breed" show will be offered. Animals that are crossbred must enter the Commercial Section.  
The registration number (where applicable) and the breed of sire must be stated on the entry form.
7. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit in each class.
8. **SUBSTITUTIONS** will be allowed in accordance with the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition (General Rule #14).
9. If numbers warrant, class will be split after entry closing at the discretion of the committee.
10. **Show numbers** must be picked up between **3:30 - 4:30 p.m., Friday, November 25, Canada Centre Lounge (CWA Office).** Exhibitor or exhibitor's parent or guardian must pick up show number package. **Upon entering the ring, exhibitor must visibly display the show number provided by CWA corresponding to the assigned entry number.**
11. The Committee reserves the right to decide on any point not covered by the rules for the proper operation of the Show.

**Prizes:**

**Breed Division Champions and Reserves plus Breed Grand Champions and Reserves will receive cash Prizes.**

## **CLASSES:**

**NOTE:** Any breed is eligible for a breed show if eight (8) or more animals of that breed are entered. All animals entering a Purebred class **MUST** be registered. Those animals not registered must enter the Commercial classes.

The Cow/Calf pairs will be shown in an Interbreed class. Champion and Reserve will advance to the Extreme. To be eligible the cow must have shown either as a calf or yearling heifer (or both) in the Junior Beef Extreme and must be entered/owned by same exhibitor.

## **COW/CALF CLASS:**

1. Female born in 2009 with own natural tattooed calf.  
The heifer calf from a cow/calf pair is eligible to be entered in the calf class. Where there is a cow/calf champion pair, the heifer calf is not eligible to compete in the heifer calf class.
2. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Cow/Calf pair.

## **PUREBRED CLASSES:**

Breed of animal must be clearly stated on entry form. Minimum of eight (8) head/breed must be entered in order to qualify for a breed show. "All Other Breeds" classes will be offered for those breeds with insufficient numbers.

3. Purebred Female, born in 2011.
4. Champion and Reserve Champion Female born in 2011.
5. Purebred Female born in 2010.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion Female born in 2010.
7. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Female.

## **COMMERCIAL CLASSES:**

Animal may be of any percentage. Splits will be made at the discretion of the committee.

8. Commercial Female, born in 2011.
9. Champion and Reserve Champion Commercial Female born in 2011.
10. Commercial Female born in 2010.
11. Champion and Reserve Champion Commercial Female born in 2010.
12. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Commercial Female.
13. Extreme Champion and Reserve Extreme Champion Female.

## **\*\*NEW\*\***

**BRED and OWNED CLASSES:** All animals must have shown in the Junior Beef Extreme open classes to be eligible for the following classes. Registration papers must state that the exhibitor is the sole breeder and sole or joint owner of the entry, and both must be declared at time of entry. All classes are Interbreed Classes. Grand and Reserve Grand Champions would not be eligible for the Extreme Champion and Reserve Extreme Champion class unless the animal placed in their Breed Class in the JBE Open show. Splits will be made at the discretion of the committee.

14. Purebred Female, born in 2011.
15. Champion and Reserve Champion Female born in 2011.
16. Purebred Female born in 2010.
17. Champion and Reserve Champion Female born in 2010.
18. Female born in 2009 with own natural tattooed calf. Calf is not eligible to show in class 14.
19. Champion and Reserve Champion Cow/Calf pair.
20. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
