SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **Ownership: All cattle must be entered under the ownership as listed on the registration certificate of the animal as of October 1.**
4. All exhibitors must be members of a National Limousin Association or National Junior Limousin Association.
5. **Weighing & Measurements:** All **cattle** will be weighed at the Show. **Scanning is optional at the exhibitors' expense.**
6. Any class larger than 15 head will be split evenly based on the number of cattle to be shown.
7. Substitutions of entries within a class may be permitted provided the animal is owned by the exhibitor at the closing date of entries (refer to General Rules).
8. All show cattle must qualify as Canadian Purebred with Canadian Limousin Association.
9. Show shirts must be worn.

SECTION 145A

CLASS

1. Female, fullblood or purebred, born in 2011. Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Junior Division will be comprised of the younger half of the 2011 heifers and the Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 heifers. Splits will be made in each Division as required.
2. Junior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
3. Senior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
4. Female, fullblood or purebred, born September 1 to December 31, 2010.
5. Female, fullblood or purebred, born January 1 to August 31, 2010. (Class splits will be made prior to Show.)
6. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female.
7. Female, fullblood or purebred, born in 2009 with her own **natural**, 2011, fullblood or purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for single calf classes, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get-of-Sire classes.
8. Female, fullblood or purebred, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own **natural**, fullblood or purebred, 2011, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for single calf classes, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get-of-Sire classes.
9. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female.
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
11. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born in 2011. Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Junior Division will be comprised of the younger half of the 2011 bulls and the Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 bulls. Splits will be made in each Division as required.

12. Junior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
13. Senior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
14. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born, September 1 to December 31, 2010.
15. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born, January 1 to August 31, 2010. (Class splits will be made prior to show.)
16. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
17. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born in 2009.
18. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
19. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
20. Breeder's Herd: A group of four purebred or fullblood animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in the previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
21. Get-of-Sire: A group of three fullblood or purebred animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. Calendar year groups accepted. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in the previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
22. Premier Breeder.
23. Premier Exhibitor.

METHOD for ESTABLISHING PREMIER BREEDER and PREMIER EXHIBITOR

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor awards will be calculated as follows:

1st place - 6 points; 2nd place - 5 points; 3rd place - 4 points; 4th place - 3 points; 5th place - 2 points; 6th place - 1 point.

- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain additional points.
- In the event of a tie, it will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd.
- Animals in joint ownership can only be shown by one owner.
- **Premier Breeder** total points will be calculated on the basis of prizes won by the six animals bred by an individual or breeding establishment, with the highest placings in the single classes. To be eligible for this award, the breeder must exhibit at the show.
- **Premier Exhibitor** total points will be calculated on the basis of prizes won by the six animals owned by the exhibitor, with the highest placings in the single classes.

HERDSMAN AWARD

A banner will be awarded to the herdsman or farm exhibitor putting on the best display during the period of Agribition. The winner will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested, when making his judgment, to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

RULES FOR SALE CATTLE

1. Cattle will be pre-selected by **September**.
2. **Entry Fee:** There will be a selection fee of \$75.00/farm. There will also be a catalogue fee of \$100.00/head, which is refundable upon the sale of the animal.
3. **Sales Commission:** To be set by the Sale Committee and to include 3% to CWA.
4. All sale cattle must be entered in the Open Show.
5. **Pregnancy:** All pregnant females selected for the sale will be pregnancy tested prior to the sale, and veterinary certificates will accompany these cattle for the sale.
