SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **Scanning:** Owner has the option to have bulls scanned. **All scanning will be done at the owner's/exhibitor's expense.**
4. All bulls must use a **Nose Ring or Humbug at all times.**
5. All Animals must be registered or recorded in a recognized herdbook.

SECTION 150A

CLASS:

1. Female, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8, born in 2010.
2. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Percentage Female.
3. Female, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8 born in 2009 with her own **natural**, tattooed registered 2011 calf at side. Calf is eligible to show in any other single classes.
4. Female, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8 born in 2008 with her own **natural**, tattooed registered 2011 calf at side. Calf is eligible to show in any other single classes.
5. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Percentage Female.
6. Female, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8, born in 2011.
7. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Percentage Female.
8. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Female.
9. Bull, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8, . Born in 2011.
10. Champion and Reserve Champion 2011 Percentage Bull.
11. Bull, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8, . Born in 2010.
12. Champion and Reserve Champion 2010 Percentage Bull.
13. Bull, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8, . Born in 2009.
14. Champion and Reserve Champion 2009 Percentage Bull.
15. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Bull.

Open Classes:

16. Female, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2010.
17. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Open Female.
18. Female, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2009, with her own **natural** 2011, tattooed, registered 3/4, Purebred or fullblood calf at side. Calf is eligible for any individual calf classes. However, the HEIFER calf on the Senior Champion is not eligible to compete in the Heifer Calf Class.
19. Female, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own **natural** 2011, tattooed, registered, 3/4 , Purebred or fullblood calf at side. Calf is eligible for any individual calf classes. However the HEIFER calf on the Senior Champion is not eligible to compete in the Heifer Calf Class.
20. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Open Female.

21. Female, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2011. (Minimum of 3 months of age). If entries exceed 20 animals, class will be divided into equal classes by age.
22. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Open Female.
23. Grand Champion Female.
24. Bull, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2011 (minimum of 3 months of age). If entries exceed 20 animals, class will be divided into equal classes by age.
25. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Open Bull.
26. Bull, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2010.
27. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Open Bull.
28. Bull, 3/4, Purebred or Fullblood, born in 2009.
29. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Open Bull.
30. Grand Champion Open Bull.

NEW - BOTH PUREBRED and PERCENTAGE points are eligible for the following:

31. Get-of-Sire: A group of three 3/4, purebred or fullblood animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have been shown in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. Name of sire must be listed on entry form when entry is made. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
32. Progeny of dam (the dam and at least one progeny must be owned by exhibitor). Two animals from one dam, animals must have been shown in the regular classes. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
33. Breeder's Herd: A group of four 3/4, purebred or fullblood animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented; must have been exhibited in previous single classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
34. Premier Breeder.
35. Premier Exhibitor.

CHAMPION HEIFER: \$5,000 plus RESERVE CHAMPION HEIFER: \$2,500 plus

\$100 entry fee allocated to class money (Top 4 in each class)

- GRAND & RESERVE CHAMPIONS become property of Sask. Maine-Anjou Association. These champions will be auctioned immediately after show. First \$5,000 for Champion will go to Sask. Maine-Anjou Association, 75% of sale over \$5,000 goes to original owner. The first \$2,500 on sale of Reserve Champion goes to Sask. Maine-Anjou Association, 75% of sale over \$2,500 goes to original owner.
- **Sponsors** will pay \$500 to **be a major player in this Classic. FIRST 10 SPONSORS ONLY!** All Sponsors will get **advertising** during the show, a **jacket** and will be a founding promoter of this ongoing show.
- The judges will be selected by 10 sponsors, whom can also judge themselves or by having a qualified cattleman judge on their behalf. Each Judge may only carry **one** card.
- All Calves **MUST** have papers to show (NOT APPLIED FOR) Maintainer 1/4, 3/8, 1/2 or 5/8 blood Maine calves.
- Each class will be placed 1 - 10 or whatever the number is in each class by all ten judges. Top placing and bottom placing will be dropped! **LOW SCORE WINS!**
- The TIE breaking judge **WILL BE POSTED ON EACH CLASS BEFORE the CLASS BEGINS!** If a tie occurs the placing on the tie breaking Judge's card breaks the tie.
- **ALL JUDGES CARDS WILL BE POSTED AFTER THE SHOW FOR COMPETITORS VIEWING.** Calves **must** be entered in the Maine-Anjou Show the following day, in the percentage classes or in the Canadian Junior Beef Extreme Show.
- Entry forms will be available through the Saskatchewan Maine Anjou Association and will also be mailed out with the Agribition Exhibitor's Handbook. Heifers entered are guaranteed as sound breeders. Breeder is responsible for transfer of sale heifer's papers.
- The Sask. Maine-Anjou Association is acting as an agent only, any grievances will be between the entrant and new owner.
- Entry deadline by mail to Megan - October 1, \$100.00/entry. Late entries received by mail October 2 - 15, \$150.00/entry. Substitution fax by November 2.
