SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$15.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **Scanning or scrotal measuring of any entries will be the option of the exhibitor.**
4. Exhibitors must wear approved Salers show attire in the ring for all classes.
5. Original registration papers (no photocopies) for all animals to be available for inspection at time of weigh-in, (no exceptions), or the animal must be removed from the barn.
6. Classes will be split equally when number of animals to be shown exceeds 15.

SECTION 170

CLASS

1. Female, purebred, born in 2009.
2. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female.
3. Female, purebred, born in 2008, with her own 2010 **natural**, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in the heifer or bull class, Breeder's Herd and Get-of-Sire classes.
4. Female, purebred, born in 2007 or earlier with her own 2010 **natural**, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in the heifer or bull class, Breeder's Herd and Get-of-Sire classes.
5. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female - Rosettes. Heifer calves shown at the side of the Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion will not be eligible to show in the heifer class. **Heifer calf entry fee will not be refunded.**
6. Female, purebred, born in 2010 (**minimum of three months of age**).
7. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
8. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
9. Bull, purebred, born 2010 (**minimum of three months of age**).
10. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
11. Bull, purebred, born in 2009.
12. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
13. Bull, purebred, born in 2008.
14. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
15. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
16. Breeder's Herd: A group of four purebred animals bred by the exhibitor. Both

sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**

17. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
18. Premier Breeder.
19. Premier Exhibitor.

PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Points from a **maximum of six head** will be used to calculate Premier Breeder /Premier Exhibitor total points. Based on points awarded to the first six places in the single breeding classes on the following basis: 1st - 6 pts; 2nd - 5 pts; 3rd - 4 pts; 4th - 3 pts; 5th - 2 pts; 6th - 1 pt. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest placing in the Breeder's Herd class will be declared the winner.

In cases where an animal is jointly owned, the person submitting the entry and summary forms must indicate on same, which owner should receive the points for Premier Exhibitor or Premier Breeder with respect to that particular animal.

Premier Exhibitor Award - Points go to the show string exhibit (breeding unit) from which animals are exhibited in single classes. Thus animals owned through partnership or among family members can contribute points towards the Premier Exhibitor Award. Fitting services not eligible.

Premier Breeder Award- Points go to the family breeding unit for animals shown in single classes. **Eligibility:** the breeder must exhibit at the Show. Joint breeders are separate entry. No extra points awarded for joint ownership. Designated breeder on registration paper will be used. Calves are not eligible if shown with dam.

Salers Cattleman's Choice

- Entries will consist of a calendar year bull and heifer calves.
- The Cattleman's Choice is an excellent opportunity to join together as breeders and show off your year of hard work.
- Memberships are available to anyone. Watch for the entry forms in the mail or contact the association. You do not have to attend Agribition to participate.
