SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **Note:** All animals coming to Agribition (whether in shows, sale or both) **must** be entered in the Main Show (Section 180A) and pay the prescribed entry fee.
4. All cattle must be in the barn prior to weighing. The Barn Boss or an SSA Director must be notified if cattle cannot arrive prior to weighing.
5. Entry requirements are a minimum of 15/16 for males and 7/8 for females as determined by the CSA rules and regulations. All animals **must have the original registration papers available for inspection** at Agribition by Monday. Sale animals whose papers are in the hands of Sale Management will be brought to Agribition by the manager. Tattoos will be checked, and improperly tattooed animals or animals without proper papers cannot show or sell at Agribition and will have to be removed from the barns.
6. **Scanning will be the option of the exhibitor.**
7. Exhibitors must wear the designated blue Saskatchewan Simmental show jacket in the show ring. These jackets will be available at Agribition.
8. Exhibitors must wear a show harness clearly showing their show number, both front and back while showing. Exhibitors wearing show numbers on their hip will be denied entry into the show ring.
9. **Note: When making entry in the Get-of-Sire & Produce-of-Dam classes, the name of the Sire for the Get-of-Sire class & the name of the Dam for Produce-of-Dam class must be listed on the entry form.**

SECTION 180A

NOTE: Any class may be split according to age if class is considered too large.

CLASS

1. Female, purebred, born January 1 to May 31, 2011. Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Junior division will be comprised of the younger half of the 2011 heifers and the Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 heifers. Splits will be made in each Division as required.
2. Junior Division Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
3. Senior Division Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
4. Female, purebred, born in 2010.
5. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female.
6. Female, purebred, born July 1 - December 31, 2009, with or without her own **natural**, purebred, 2011, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 11, but eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire & Produce-of-Dam classes.
7. Female, purebred, born in January 1 - June 30, 2009, with her own **natural**, purebred, 2011, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for classes 1 or 11, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire & Produce-of-Dam classes.
8. Female, purebred born in 2008 or earlier, with her own natural, purebred, 2011, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 11, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire, & Produce-of-Dam classes.
9. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female.
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.

11. Bull, purebred, born in 2011. Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Junior division will be comprised of the younger half of the 2011 bulls and the Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 bulls. Splits will be made in each Division as required.
12. Junior Division Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
13. Senior Division Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
14. Bull, purebred, born in 2010.
15. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
16. Bull, purebred, born in 2009.
17. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
18. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
19. Produce-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age, from the same Dam. At least one animal owned by exhibitor. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. **Name of Dam must be listed on entry form when making entry. No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
20. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have been exhibited in the previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **Name of sire must be listed on entry form when making entry. No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
21. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in the previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Cow/calf entry will be considered 2 separate animals. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
22. Premier Breeder.
23. Premier Exhibitor.

HERDSMAN AWARD

*A trophy donated by **Bouchard Livestock International**, will be awarded to the herdsman or farm exhibitor putting on the best display during the period of Agribition. The method of selection will be left to the donor.*

SIMMENTAL SALE RULES

1. **Eligible Animals:** Fullblood and purebred females and bulls. Sale requirements are a minimum of 15/16 for males and 7/8 for females as determined by the CSA rules and regulations.
2. **Females:** Class champions and reserve class champions showing in the Main Show, Junior Beef Extreme and First Lady Classic (if Simmental) are eligible for the sale subject to approval by the Saskatchewan Simmental Association (SSA) Show & Sale Committee. All other sale females must be nominated and on-farm selected.
3. **Bulls:** Will be nominated and on farm selected by sale management. Sale management will also have the option of selecting a limited number of bulls at Agribition subject to the approval of the SSA show and sale committee.
4. Saskatchewan consignors must be paid up members of the Saskatchewan Simmental Association.
5. CWA show entry fees must be paid to Canadian Western Agribition.
6. Sale commission is 13% plus 3% to Canadian Western Agribition.
7. All animals are exportable.
8. All females require a veterinary certificate as to pregnancy status.
